- Coordinating and leading all aspects of the weekly Friday Night Youth Service, Refuel programs during weekend services and Young Adults Combined Connects and Events.
- Oversee outreach expressions, such as High Schools and University ministries.
- Providing Pastoral Care and follow up for new teenagers, young adults, and their families.

This role is located at our **Port Kennedy Campus** and the successful candidate would need to make this their home church.

A successful candidate will have a passion for teenagers and young adults with previous experience in leadership. Be a team player with a high level of networking and relational strengths.

They will have great time management skills, attention to detail and communication skills.
