




BUDGET ALLOCATION OVERVIEW

In 2025, Nations Church continued to make a lasting community impact through initiatives that foster care, inclusion, and hope. From supporting families in need to partnering with local schools to providing food hampers, playgroups, and outreach events, each program reflected the heart of Jesus in action—building connection, meeting practical needs, and transforming lives across Western Australia.



LOVE COMMUNITY CHRISTMAS PARTIES

Nations Church hosts Love Community Christmas Parties across all WA campuses, reaching thousands throughout the festive season. Last year, 1456 people from the community attended our Love Community events. These celebrations share the love of Christ, extend invitations to Christmas Eve services, and create powerful opportunities for connection, evangelism, and genuine community care.



In 2025, Heroes Academy hosted Mega Play Dates in Bunbury, Myaree, and Port Kennedy, engaging 160 families with additional needs. Supported by Nations Church and Curtin University volunteers, the ministry fosters care, inclusion, and community through Mega Play Dates, Sunday services, and a sensory playgroup across Perth and the South West.

YOUTH & HIGH SCHOOLS

Nations Church Youth connect with hundreds of students through fortnightly lunchtimes programs in schools like Rockingham, Kennedy Baptists, and Belmont City College. These initiatives build relationships, support new students, and improve school culture. Many have joined youth programs and come to faith, with a recent outreach night seeing 299 attend, 13 salvations and 1 healing. Alongside high school outreaches, Nations Church also support many chaplains across the state.

KIDS DEPARTMENT

Nations Kids transformed the Meeting Hall at Myaree into a cinema for a Holiday Movie Night, engaging 27 new children and families—some attending church for the first time. Following its success, a second Family Movie Night in November will feature 'The Star' as a Christmas outreach. In Port Kennedy, a Community Disco drew 37% community attendance, with one family visiting church that weekend after asking how to get involved. Our Port Kennedy and Myaree teams also supported local primary school with ongoing support to chaplains, coffee mornings and morning teas for teachers.

AUSLAN

Nations Church offers Auslan interpretation for Kids Curriculum and monthly Myaree services, ensuring the deaf community full access to the gospel and genuine inclusion in church life.

YOUNG ADULTS

Nations Church Young Adults have a team, which leads fortnightly street evangelism in Northbridge, sharing Jesus through Go Nights and Go Week with BBQs, care packs, prayer, and bold conversations. A recent outreach saw 6 salvations, 12 healings, and dozens encountering the gospel—fueling a growing passion among young adults to transform their community.

FOOD PANTRY

In 2025, the Port Kennedy Food Pantry, in partnership with OzHarvest, distributed 2,000 hampers to chaplains and local families. With team members supporting 30 families, 3 were saved and baptised, and many received prayer and hope. More than food, it became a space of care and connection—where one recipient was inspired to join the team and give back. We also started up 10 dry food pantries in 10 Rockingham schools to help assist in supporting families.

COMMUNITY SOCCER EVENT

Nations Church Belmont partnered with YWAM to host a four-day community soccer clinic, combining sport with the message of hope. Across the week, the gospel was shared and 23 local families were reached, building connection, faith, and community spirit.

COMMUNITY CHRISTMAS HAMPERS

This year, Nations Church is blessing the local community with 1,200 Christmas gift hampers, inviting each recipient to our Love Community Christmas parties and Christmas Eve services. This initiative powerfully shares the love of Christ—spreading joy, fostering connection, and celebrating together.



KING EDWARD MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

Nations Church donated 180 sets of winter maternity clothing to support vulnerable pregnant women at King Edward Memorial Hospital. The hospital's Social Work Department expressed heartfelt gratitude, noting that the donation brought dignity, comfort, and hope to women facing financial hardship and isolation. We also donated 200 teddy bears to babies born into foster care within the hospital. This act of generosity helped mothers feel seen, valued, and cared for during one of the most challenging seasons of their lives.


PLAYGROUP AND ALPHA PARENTING COURSE

Nations Church Playgroups engage over 2,000 parents and children across Belmont, Bunbury, Myaree, and Port Kennedy. Many non-church families find a welcoming, relational space where connections and faith naturally grow. Mums share the gospel, invite families to programs, and host Alpha Parenting courses. We also have a new Wangara playgroup launching in 2026.

HANNAH'S HOUSE

Nations Church partners with Hannah's House by opening its Heroes Academy Sensory Room eight times a year for families with children facing life-limiting conditions, offering play, coffee, and care. The church also provides emergency meals, Christmas hampers, books, and a \$5,000 equipment donation to support families in crisis. Hannah's House expressed deep gratitude, noting the partnership brings comfort, joy, and lasting impact to the families they serve.

TRANSFORM CAMBODIA

In 2025, Transform Cambodia continued to grow and impact lives across the nation. Through our partnership, 143 Nations Church sponsored children were supported, over 300 new students joined the program, and the largest-ever Year 12 class of 302 graduated—most continuing to university. With 43 new tertiary graduates now among 115 alumni leading change in their communities, families are also being transformed through ongoing care and support. As Transform Cambodia nears its 20th anniversary, we celebrate two decades of partnership and lasting impact.

YOUTH ALIVE

In 2025, the Gospel reached over 5,000 young people, with 722 faith commitments and more than 500 Bibles distributed. A total of 432 leaders were equipped, and powerful gatherings were held across WA—including 4,700 at Main Event, 1,000 at Conference, 2,200 at rallies, and 600 young adults at All In. Momentum continued to build as lives were changed and the next generation empowered.

ALPHA

In 2025, Alpha reached over one million Australians with the Gospel, made possible through the generosity of partners like Nations Church. Across the nation, 2,565 churches ran Alpha, equipping believers, reaching young people, and helping churches stay on mission.

IMPACT STATEMENTS PARTNER ORGANISATIONS

SONSHINE FM

In 2025, Sonshine FM reached 314,000 listeners each month, including nearly 129,000 with no connection to Jesus. Through the partnership of Nations Church, the message of hope and the love of Christ continued to fill cars, homes, and workplaces across the nation.

STREET CHAPLAINCY

In 2025, Street Chaplains WA continued caring for the most vulnerable in our communities, working alongside Police and Paramedics to bring compassion and support to those in need. This year, funding helped replace vital defibrillators and provide hundreds of blankets during the colder months—offering warmth, safety, and hope on our streets.

IRIS

In 2025, Iris continued to see lives transformed and Jesus glorified across Cambodia through our partnership with Nations Church. This Kingdom collaboration has brought both generous financial support and the blessing of visiting teams from Perth—each carrying fresh fire, encouragement, and hope. Together, we've strengthened local leaders, reached vulnerable communities, and witnessed lasting spiritual and practical impact in the lives of those we serve.

ACCI

In 2025, ACCI Relief continued to bring holistic transformation to individuals, families, and communities around the world. Empowering people to overcome injustice and break the cycle of poverty, their work upheld the dignity and rights of every person. Guided by Christian principles of justice and equality, ACCI championed community-led change—ensuring that people were equipped to shape their own futures and that every child's right to a family was protected.

PROJECT VALENTINE

Project Valentine has reached over 100 women with gifts and connection, expanding into new brothels south of the river. A new prayer initiative has opened doors for two women to find salvation, men leaving brothels, and tangible transformation in local communities once impacted by crime.

SPORTSCARE CHAPLAINCY

In 2025, SportsCARE Chaplaincy continued partnering with local sports clubs across WA to support athletes, coaches, and teams—caring for body, mind, and soul. Through our partnership, over 40 chaplains now serve across 11 sporting codes, responding to 22 critical incidents and providing vital pastoral care and support when it mattered most.


BURNING HEARTS MOVEMENT

Through the Burning Hearts Movement, we reached thousands across Thailand, Ireland, and the UK with the Gospel. In Thailand, teams trained 240 youth and leaders, sharing Jesus with 727 people and seeing 198 salvations. Across Ireland and the UK, 308 people came to faith through evangelism and partnership with Awakening Europe. Nations Church's support also helped resource a worship tour uniting churches and igniting revival across these regions.

IMPACT STATEMENTS GLOBAL MISSIONS TRIPS

In 2025, Nations Church continued to reach the nations through missions both internationally and in regional WA. Teams shared the Gospel, witnessed salvations and healings, and equipped local leaders and churches. From ministering in schools and villages to supporting communities with care and encouragement, each trip reflected God's heart for the nations.



Our Europe Missions Trip was a powerful, life-changing experience. Around 400 people heard the Gospel, with over 40 decisions for Christ and about 30 healings—backs restored and pain instantly gone through prayer and evangelism. Partnering with Awakening Europe (which saw over 6,000 salvations) and encouraging our Cork Campus alongside the Perth team, we witnessed incredible moments—like one young man accepting Jesus just 20 seconds after hearing the Gospel. Ireland is truly awakening to the good news.

THAILAND

Our team partnered with local ministries across Thailand to share the Gospel through trainings, kids' camps, and village outreaches. We witnessed salvations, healings, and restored identities in Christ. Leaders were equipped, families strengthened, and children encountered God's love and power—lives were truly transformed.

COOLGARDIE

Nations Church served at CAPS, a Christian Aboriginal school, supporting teachers and connecting with students during their Transition Week. In Kurrawang, our team ministered to the community, partnering with local churches to bring hope and encouragement. We saw students soften with joy, teachers moved to tears of gratitude, and local believers renewed in faith. The school was blessed with a new inflatable, and we've been invited back in November to continue the work God has begun.

PHILIPPINES

In 2025, a team of ten partnered with local churches, NGOs, and schools across Pampanga, Laguna, Batangas, and Cebu. Together, they empowered leaders, shared the Gospel in schools, ministered to families, and loved children rescued from challenging situations. Nearly 200 people came to salvation, with powerful physical and emotional healings witnessed throughout the trip. The Holy Spirit moved mightily across the Philippines—marking the beginning of an even greater outpouring of His love and power in this nation.

CAMBODIA

Our Cambodia Missions Trip was a powerful time of ministry. The prayer team equipped church members at Nations Church Phnom Penh in intercession, prophecy, and hearing God's voice—seeing healings, deliverance, and deep encounters with the Father's love.

Meanwhile, the worship and production team partnered with local leaders to develop skills, upgrade equipment, and strengthen team culture through hands-on training and conference support. We also had our Nations College team head over to support the new Kampong Speu outreach providing practical support in building and maintenance.

INDONESIA

From schools to churches and community hubs across Indonesia, our team equipped leaders and supported children with additional needs. At Tunas Bangsa School, our training empowered educators to expand inclusion from just one student to over one hundred. Through teaching, encouragement, and hands-on ministry, we ministered to families, parents, and volunteers—seeing lives and communities transformed by God's love.
